FROM THE PRINCIPAL:

Welcome to week 2 term 3, a term that traditionally seems to fly by very quickly as is a very busy term.

One of the things that makes this term busy is athletics and the students are already practising for the up coming carnival in week 6. Before that though, in week 4, we have the Lap-a-thon which is a fundraiser for the P and C and organising for that event is well underway. The Lap-a-thon is a fun afternoon and parents are welcome to join their children for a lap, or 20 laps, of our oval.
